The distinguished American tenor Grayson Hirst, a professor of voice at the University of Arizona, founded Orpheus in the fall of 1991 with the aid of a UA Fine Arts Incentive Grant award. Dubbed the "Chorus that cares," Orpheus regularly performs for community support organizations such as New Beginnings (formerly Shalom House), the MS Society, La Frontera, the Patronato of Mission San Xavier del Bac, Casa de los Niños, Southern Arizona AIDS Foundation and Save the Children.
